## 1 Respective responsibilities of the auditor and the authority

Our responsibility as auditors to complete a limited assurance review is set out by the National Audit Office (NAO). ## 2 External auditor's limited assurance opinion 2023/24

Except for the matters reported below, on the basis of our review of Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), in our opinion the information in Sections 1 and 2 of the AGAR is in accordance with Proper Practices and no other matters have come to our attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met.

The AGAR was not accurately completed before submission for review. Please ensure that amendments are corrected in the prior year comparatives when completing next year's AGAR.:

• Section 2, Box 2 is incorrect due to a transposition error and should read £30,978.

- The smaller authority has not addressed the 'except for' matter raised by the external auditor when qualifying the prior year AGAR. The smaller authority has not restated the prior year figure to recognise assets purchased during that year
- The smaller authority has not addressed the 'except for' matter raised by the external auditor when qualifying the prior year annual return. Whilst the accounts have been restated on an income and expenditure basis, Section 2, Boxes 1 and 3 for the prior year are incorrect. This is due to the treatment of VAT. The 2022/23 Box 1 figure should not agree to the 2021/22 Box 8 figure on the change of accounting basis.
